 or Legacies Given them paid by my Executors hereafter mentioned at age
 of Eighteen years of age and to have a benefit of their Labour at Sixteen
 years if they have opportunity to learn some Trade -

Shooters and one powder Dish marked R by one Gun and sword and the
Fire makers tools he usually works with

I Give and bequeath to my Son Wm Penny one feather bed Rug and Shooters
one great puter Dish and basin one Pew and two Over one gun with
Galleons

Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Penny one feather bed and one great
puter Dish and basin

Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Margret Williams five hundred pounds
of Tobacco to be paid by my Executors

Item I Give and bequeath to my Grandson John Williams one Cowardin

Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Eliza Right one Dish and one hand of puter

Item I Give and bequeath all of Rest of my Estate whatsoever both house hold goods
Cattle Dole Dore whatsoever to my Dear & Loving Wife Lucy penny after
my Just Debt are paid Lastly I Do hereby nominate and appoint my Dear
and Loving Wife Lucy penny my Whole & Sole Exor of this my Last will
and Testament for Writ of here of I have hereunto set my hand this
17 Day of May in the year of our Lord 1715
