 vance I give Devise bequeath and Dispose of In manner following
 I Leave and bequeath unto William Walkers the Son of John Walk-
 -kins Who now Liveth to me a piece of Land which I give in my brother

 and four Right I also give him one feather bed & furniture a horse bridle & Saddle two Cows & Calves six Sheep forty heads of Hogs a Table & Chest his Choice of six of my pewter Dishes Eight plates Three basons a Dozen of Spoons four pewningors 1 quart Tankard a pewter Ham tin Pot a pewter Salt Seder a Brass Candle Stick a pair of Stillars or Ypres; a Spice Morter and pestle the Price of my Guns six Glasse Bottles my Sickles a Drawing Knife a Taffing Dish a bible a Brass pepper box a funnoll an Iron Pot & Hooks a hoe an Aacham iron & hatchet Twelve hundred pounds of Tobacco a Grubbing hoe and for 4 afore said forty heads of Hogs not to be any part of 4 Hogs which he is of his mark th uss about my Plantation for they are properly his already. also I give him Eight Barrels of Indian Corn fifteen Bushels of Wheat; a pair of Iron Tonges a Looking Glasse and what nails I have which is out of use my great Loe (Pat & Ester) Hat a hand Sore & two stone Suggs six wooden bowls a frying pan

Item I Give unto James Watkins of Son of John Watkins afore said one Iron Pot & a Gun one Rest

Item I Give unto Isaac Riches one Sword and belt & my wearing apparell

Item I Give unto Abraham Riches what Money I have in my house and what Money is owing to me Excepting that Money to my Brother Robt. Riches owes me and two Cows & Calves and two of 4 best Steers I have one Taffing Dish

Item I Give unto my Brother Robt. Riches what Money & Tobacco he owes me and a Cane

Item I Give my Negre Woman Jone unto my Brother James Riches six pewter Dishes and six plates and three basons

Item I Give unto my Sister Jane Riches my trunk 4 five pewter Dishes and five plates and two Thousand pound of pork to be paid her here at my plantation and for the rest of my Movable Estate I give unto my brother James and my Sister Jane Riches to be Equally Divided among them; and further I Do here by Appoint to leave my Brothers Abraham Riches and Robert Riches my Executors of this my Last will and Testament to see it truly performed and Lastly I Do here by Revoke all other wills & Testaments and only Acknowledging this to be my Last will and Testament as now giving under my hand and Seal this Eighth Day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eleven
