Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary Whitty one little table one deep pater Dish one old pater Dish wth one brim & a pater plate one three year old steer —

Item I give & bequeath to my son Madison Street one Mare bridle & saddle one great Iron pot Item I further give to my son Madison & my daughter Mary Whitty one new pair of Cart wheels joyntly between them both for the use of their plantation —
