I give to my Daughter Rachell two Ewes & Lambs and one hys

I give to my Daughter Mary one Cow & Calf

I give to my Son Joshua my long Gun one Bell of Shoe makers tools
one flaxing Kniife & my Tobacco Sticks & pipe & School plies
I give to my Daughter Elizabeth one Iron Bell two Ewes & Lambs
I give to my Son Matthew my small Gun & one pair of Shoe makers
pinchers Nippers & hammer and one vesting Large British Physi
cian

I give to my Daughter Margaret one Grob Cuffe

I give to my Daughter Susanna one Crot & Calf

I give to my Child my Wife is with God without her son or Daughter one
feather bed & furniture this Likewise my wife and Desire that my two
Brother Robert & Matthew have value & remainder of my Estate and
Divide it in three parts my wife to have one & the other two to be di
vided amongst my Children with that like my wife goes with it
it is Likewise my will & I Do nominate appoint & desire my Dear
and Loving wife Elizabeth my whole and sole Executrix of this my
Last will & testament in witness hereof I have hereunto set my
hand & fixed my seal this 28 of February 1717

and after her Deceas I give & Bequeath of said five Negroe
tong Quomony & Moll & Vanny & Simon to be Equally Divided
between my Children Richard Cornelius John & Mary & Robecah
the children of my two deceased Daughters Elizabeth & Sarah to have
a full part apiece that is Eliz. Children to have one full part
Equally Divided amongst them & Sarahs Children to have a full
part Equally Divided amongst them my (Daughters Children
and & heirs of their bodies lawfully begotten for ever but if my two Sons in
Law) viz Thomas Soneman & his band of Mary & Richard Forster
