 - Item I Give to my two Sons Nicholas & Joseph Smith the two Cows that I now
 Lay on with the furniture thereto belonging
 - Item I Give to my Grand Son Will: Smith a pare of pistols
 - Item I Give to my Grand Son Peter Lugg two Ewes
 - Item I Give to my Grand Son Nathanael Parker two Ewe Lambs
 - Item I Give to my Son Nicholas Smith one Coffer Chest
- and all the rest of my Estate what so ever or where so ever
 with in Doors or without I Give unto my four Children that
 is to say Nicholas Smith Joseph Smith ann Smith and Martha
 Smith to be Equally Divided between them except my still
 which I Give to my two Sons Nicholas and Joseph Smith and
 my will is that my friends Will: Green John Pitt & Henry Pitt
 Divide the same according to the kind thereof and do hereby
 constitute my Son Joseph Smith to be my whole Exorator of
 this my last will and Testament as Witness my hand this twenty
 day of October one thousand seven hundred & fifty seven
