I give unto my Son-in-law Joseph Vaper of London being atty. counsellor of a small Branch of a marked off & sold along a parcel of marsh lands to John Lunt & so along by Lunt to the Church Lunt to John Lunt & so to John Lunt Station, to have his Heires for ever, & all my Cooper's Tools

I give & bequeath unto my Son-in-law Peter Vaper, One Heifer of four years Old atty. Spring, & my Great Hunting Horn, & my Every day Hat

I give & bequeath unto my Son-in-law Vaper, my Every day Coat & Waist Coat, & my Shoemakers Tools & my postle & One pair of Fishing Brethren

I give & bequeath unto my Son-in-law Vaper, One Every Land & my Broadcloth Coat & my Great Hat & my Every day Hat

I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Vaper, One Good Ring containing Jewels & Thirty Shillings after her Mother's decease

I give & bequeath unto my Son-in-law Vaper, One flannelled Rugs & Blanket, & two Heifers of four years Old atty. Spring, One Sow & Pigs

I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Vaper One Sow & Lamb atty. day of Marriage

I give & bequeath unto my Son-in-law Joseph Vaper, all the rest of my Lands, House Orchard & Out House & all other Conventions, to him & his Heires for ever, and in Case that he dye without Issue of his Body, then to return to my Son-in-law Vaper

And all the rest of my worldly goods, I give unto my true beloved Wife, Margaret Vaper, making for my full & whole Exe of this my last will & Testament, as witness my hand this 22nd day of Jan^y 1678
