Item I give to my Loving Loving Wife Anne the plantation whereon I now live bounded thus beginning at a Corner tree of Francis Williamsons and running thence downe a Branch called the long branch to the Main run of a Swamp and by the said run to my line thence on my line to the first Station to all and singular the Houses Edifices Gardens Orchards wood waies water and all other appurtenances thereto belonging or that may belong to the said land to be held and Enjoyed by my said Wife during her natural life and from and immediately after the departure of her said natural life the said lands and all the said privileges above mentioned to my Wife to her my Son Edward Fulghame and the heirs of his Body lawfully begotten for Ever and if my son Edward die without such heirs then my Will intent is that his part shall go my Son John and if my son John die without such heirs then his part to fall to Edward and if my son Anthony die without such heirs then his part to fall to my Son Michall and if my son Michall die without such heirs then his part to fall to my Son Anthony and so to fall them and from them to the heirs of their Bodies lawfully begotten for Ever =

All in resp and testime of my owne free Gods and Chastell forever I give and bequeath to my Loving Wife Anne whom I appoint and make my full and whole Exe of this my Last Will and testament =

And I do hereby revoke dissolve and make void all former Wills and testaments by me heretofore made or spoken of in Witness whereof I the said John Fulghame to this my Last Will and testament do set my hand the 4th day of June 1601

In the name of God Amen I Rich: Reynolds of the parish of Newport in the Shire of Wight County for by long sickness and sick of Body but thanks be to Almighty of a sound and perfect mind and memory I do make and ordaine this my last Will and testament in Manner and forme as followeth =

I give and Bequeath my Soul to Almighty God Hoping through the blessed merits of Jesus Christ to have full pardon of all my Sins and my Body to the Earth to be decently buried by loving Wife and Children and as to my World Goods to please God to keep me to I give and Bequeath as follows

I give and Bequeath to my Loving Wife Elizabeth during her Natural life this plantation that I now live on to all the Appurtenances she making no will full that the plantation is bounded thus beginning at the Mouth of the Freshet Swamp 100 by the said Freshet Swamp 100 feet as to the mouth of a deep branch in that waile below the old Mill Pond and thence by the said Branch to a marked Maple standing in the head thereof thence Strike to the Line that divid this Land and the Land that was formerly Mr. Chick's bordering alike about an old Sawpitt and so downe the said Line to the Creek and down the said Creek to the former Freshet Swamp

I give and Bequeath to my Loving Son Richard Reynolds this plantation according to the above mentioned Bound after my Wife decess to him and his heirs of his Body lawfully Begotten for Ever

I give and give and Bequeath to my Loving Son Sharpe Reynolds all my Land and plantation on the North Easterly side of the Freshet Swamp and Marsh Ground unto him and heirs of Body lawfully begotten for Ever

I give and Bequeath unto my Loving Son Christopher Reynolds all my Land above the Deep branch that is that is bounds of the Land and plantation that I now live on lying about three hundred and twenty acres of Land to Edward Griffiths his or Part of the Land unto the said Christopher and his heirs of his Body lawfully begotten

I give and Bequeath unto Richd Jackson that Land which I have sold to him and given Bond for the Redwood of it where I have agreed for it being bounded to the Maine Blackwater Swamp and a Corp branch to make an Island to him the said Richd Jackson and his heirs for Ever

I give and Bequeath unto my Son Christopher Reynolds all the remaining part of that Land that is lying to the Land that I gave to Richard Jackson to him the said Christopher and his heirs for Ever

I give unto my Son Richard Reynolds that plantation and Land that Georg Shode live on up to Round Swamp Bottom unto him and heirs during the tenure of the lease

I give unto my Son Sharpe Reynolds that plantation and Land to him given him on from the Round Swamp bottom up as far as the Land goes unto him and his heirs during the tenure of the Lease

I give unto my Son Richd Reynolds all that plantation Land and Marsh that he now live on to him and his heirs of his Body lawfully begotten for Ever

I give unto my Loving Wife during her Widowhood the Use and Service of Negro Boys and Negro Girls Nam and upon her death or Marriag- to shall please God to happen full that then I give to my to my Son Richd and his heirs after my Wife Marriag or death

I give to my Son Sharpe and his heirs after my Wife death or Marriag

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I give Kari and her increase to my Son Christopher and his heirs after my ^{life} Marriage or Death

I give unto my Grandson Reynolds my Negro boy to him the said Rich^d Reynolds and his heirs

I give unto my Loving Wife my Negro Woman Phillis and Negro girl Mary

I give unto my Son Tharpe my Mare and her increase and my Small Team and two New Silver Spoons

I give unto my Son Christopher my mare poney and her increase my great Gun gun and two New Silver Spoons

I give my Will is that what he is due to the Estate of Elizth Lewis one of the Daughters of of Rich^d Lewis be paid what he has paid and Bought for her already shall be paid out of the Rents of my Land anything to the contrary notwithstanding

I give my Will is that my Land is to remaine where it is and the Use of it to my Sons Richard Tharpe and Christopher and their heirs my Wife is to have the Use of it

I give all the rest of my Estate whatsoever unto my Loving my Loving Son — Rich^d Tharpe and Christopher Equally to be divided between them my Son Richard is to answer for what he has had already of me Excepting his Swords gun and Spoons and to that he is to have an Equal Share and my Desire is that they may share what there is among themselves

I do ordaine and Appoint my Loving Wife my Loving Son Rich^d Reynolds Tharpe Reynolds and Christopher Reynolds my whole and Sole Ex^{ors} and Ex^{ors} of my last Will and testament and I do hereby bequeath and make void all other Will — or bequestes whatsoever in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this — twenty seven Day of July one thousand seven hundred and Eleven
