I give and bequeath to my Son Phillip Lupp a gr of old pistols and powder and a

gun - I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Lillbourn a Young Steer -

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Anne Biddgood a Cow -

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Lupp a Cow and the feather Bed in Room furnished the said Life in -

I give and bequeath to my Eldest Daughter Biddgood a young Steer -

I give and bequeath to my Son John Lupp my Gun and Sword and my Young Mare and a Young Heifer when he comes to the Age of Sixteen Years -

I give and bequeath to my loving Wife Sarah all the Residue and Remains of my Estate during her Natural Life and after her death I give and bequeath unto my Son John Lupp and do make her my said Love Wife whole and Sole Ex^{or} of this my Last Will and Testament in testimony of which I have hereunto put my Hand and Seal this 11th of Aug^r 1712
