 Wife Elizabeth the use of all my personall Estate during her natu-
 -rall Life and after her Decease I give & bequeath all my afore
 -s^d personall Estate unto my three Sons Richard Cornelius and John
 and my two Daughters Mary & Rebecca if their husbands shall al-
 -low y^e ten pounds or y^e two Thousand pounds of Tobacco each of them
 Else not y^e come my two Deceased Daughters Children each their
 parts lastly I do here by Nominate and appoint my Dear and Lov-
 -ing Wife Elizabeth to be Executrix and my son Richard to be Ex-
 -ecutor of this my Last Will and Testament for Witness hereof I

I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Philomen five pounds worth of my Estate to be Equally Divided amongst them all seven and as for all of Remaining part of My Estate both within and with out of What nature or Quality soever I give to be Equally Divided Between my Loving Wife Mary Smith Mary Kitchell and my Daughter Martha Smith according to the Mind thereof and Do Request my Couson Joseph Smith and Mr Henry Pitt and Mr Green to Divide the Same according to of Quality thereof and I do Nominate and appoint my Loving Wife Mary Smith and my Couson Joseph Smith to be my Executors to See this my Will performed as Witness my hand this 5th of May 1718
