 Give my Estate as following

 come to the Age of twenty one years

I Give to my Cousin John Altman Son of Garrett Altman all my Wearing
 Apparell after my Decease to be delivered to him by my Ex^{rs} hereafter Named

I Give to my Cousin Altman one Yearling Heifer to be paid to him at the Age
 of twenty one years

I Give and Bequeath to my Loving Wife Eliz^a Altman all the rest of my
 Estate during her Natural life and if ever any of my Wives Relations should
 come come for this Country then I order that my Estate be Equally divided
 between my Consens to whom I have given Legacies and my Wife Cons^{ent} if
 any should come but if my Wives Relations should never come to this Country
 then I order that order that after my Wives Decease my Estate to be Equally
 divided between my Consens to whom I have given Legacies they not
 Misliking my Wife during her life

I Give to my Cousin John Altman son of John Altman one Gun
 I Give to my Cousin John Altman Son of Garrett Altman one Gun after my
 Decease

I Revoke all other Will and Deeds and order this my Last Will and Testament
 and I leave my dear and Loving Wife Eliz^a Altman my whole and sole Ex^{rs}
 of this my Last Will and Testament Witness my hand and Seal this 14th day of May 1712
