Quision to have his First Portion when he shall arrive to the Age of nineteen years and  
if either of them shall depart this life before the Heir of their Portion shall be 40 then  
to the Surviving of them and the Heir of their Portion 100 full years for ever

To me to my four sons William Thomas James Joseph and John B. Child & 1/4 of them one  
 Roderick Cow when they they shall arrive to the Age of majority one year -

Spine and Legueath Entom. Dr. Joseph one set of No. 1000 tools when he shall have  
to Henry Board of Ag.

I will add Cognac to my Tea both my gun well fixed when he shall arrive so -  
thirty years of age -

Give to my two sons William Thomas George and James and send to each of them one  
pinner plate and two pinner spoons when they shall again be out of the hospital.

At the sale of Estate Goods and Chattels movable and of the Land therein situate after my  
Debt and funeral Expenses paid I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary  
Bullock (now my wife) and Whose &c of this my Gift of the said Land and so to request  
my Brother William Bullock and Jack Bullock to Go & execute of my will of the  
testament to be performed and Do so that I may not be troubled with the same  
made in Witness whereof I have signed hand and Seal my last for many kind say of  
January 14<sup>th</sup> 1792
