Item I Give & bequeath unto my daughter Mary Green my Indian Girl called Pinks for &
during y^e Natural life of y^e Marye aft^r her decease unto y^e heirs of her body lawfully
begotten for ever

Item I Give & bequeath unto my son ^{my loving wife} West my Indian Girl called Ross, for & during
his natural life, & after his decease unto y^e heirs of his body lawfully begotten for ever.

Item I Give & bequeath unto my negroes Tony, & Jack, & my Indian Boy, so long as he shall
live a Widow: but if she marry or dye y^e I give my negro Tony, unto my son Kirtle West,
wth y^e heirs of his body lawfully begotten for ever. And my Negroe Jack unto my son
Kirtle West, wth y^e heirs of his body lawfully begotten for ever. And my Indian woman Bay
unto my daughter Rebekah West, wth y^e heirs of her body lawfully begotten for ever.

Item I Give & bequeath unto my loving wife, & my daughter Rebekah, all y^e part of my
personal Estate now or hereafter to be equally divided, between my said loving
Wife & my Daughter Rebekah; And I doe appoint my said loving wife, my whole & sole
of this my last will & testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
