 I give & bequeath unto Thomas Sawyer & Ysabel his wife a parcel of Land purchased of James Paddon beginning on the above said Land, containing eighty eight Acres more or less to them & their heirs for ever
 I give & bequeath to John's of the above said hundred Acres, of Land to my Son-in-law Thomas Sawyer, his heirs & for ever
 I give & bequeath my land & tenements & furniture & moveables to my Grandson John Sawyer, as also my Coat & a Cup
 I give & bequeath one Shilling & four pence to my Granddaughter Mary Sawyer
 One good pointer dog
 I give & bequeath my Granddaughter Sarah Sawyer, five large pointer dogs & a Drifping ham & one pot of four gallons
 One pointer flaggon, & a spirit & a spirit bottle

 To my Granddaughter Elizabeth Fizer One Cow
