Item Further I give to my daughter Anne a flesh fork one Iron ladle & four ewes & a Ram five Cows & three fellows and Gods make my loving son in law John Turner my whole & Sole Executor to see this my last will performed as Witness my hand & Seal this 11th day of November 1710.

 when she shall come to age I do nominate & appoint
 my Giles Diner Jur^{or} to be whole & Sole Exec^r of this my
 last will & Testament & I do hereby revoke & disallow of all
 other wills by me heretofore made or Witness my hand
 & Seal this 31th day of March 1711.
