To two Tables to one Chest to Eight flagged Chairs to one Safe to one  
Leather trunk to one Trunk to two Frying Pans to one pair of fire tongs  
to one Spitt to one Chaffing Dish to one Grin Stone to one Brass Kettle  
to one Bell mouth to one Small fowling piece to one Case  
of Pistols and Holsters to two Swords to two Saddles to three Bridles to one  
Iron Candle stick to five powder Dishes to three Basins of powder also  
to one powder porringer to one Quart Pot to eight powder plates to two more  
powder Spoons to fourteen Earthen pangs to five Earthen Potts to six  
Earthen Cups to two mugs Earthen to Seventeen Silver Cask to one  
Iron Bottle to one Iron Jum or to one flask for R to two Washing tubs  
to Eight Water pails to three Iron Wagges to one Coff Cut Saw to the hand  
Saw to one Chaffing Dish to one Cart & Wheeles to one Boat and Sails  
to one Horse to one Mares to fourtoon head of Cattle to fifteen &

weak of Body but full of Somememory failing to mind of uncertain-  
ty of this present Life and knowing that all men must Die I think fit to  
make this my last will and testament to Dispose of all my worldly  
goods and Estate as God has been pleased to bestow on me w<sup>t</sup> followeth and  
enitting my Soul to God & my body to have a Christian burial at the  
Discretion of God here after named

1<sup>st</sup> I Give unto my Dear & well beloved wife Elizabeth a Room well  
furnished with all such necessaries as she shall reasonably have  
occasion out of my Estate and to be kept so furnished by my Ex<sup>r</sup> & also  
I leave her three negroes During her natural life that is to say  
John Dyer and Frank & also her Riding mare

2<sup>nd</sup> I Give Equality between my two Sons William Scott and Robert Scott  
my water mill to them and their heirs & Ever also I do leave unto  
my son Wm of use of one third part of my orchard lie no man of his  
own

3<sup>rd</sup> I Give unto my son John Scott all my tract of Land lying on the

South side of King's Dale Swamp in Isle of wight County I give  
it to him and his heirs for ever.

<sup>4<sup>th</sup> Give unto my son Robert Scott my plantation now living on with all  
the Land belonging to it I give them and his heirs for ever &  
also my tract of Land appertaining to both rooms and Pit I give it  
to him & to Robert and his heirs for ever and also I give him my  
Negro boy called Mingo and also I give him my long table  
and Cupboard.</sup>

<sup>5<sup>th</sup> Give unto my Daughter Elizabeth Holloway a feather bed  
with furniture.</sup>

<sup>6<sup>th</sup> Give unto my Grandson John Holloway a young mare Excepting  
first 3<sup>ds</sup> of it to me I shall bring & give to my grandson John Holloway</sup>

<sup>7<sup>th</sup> Give unto my Grandson Will Holloway a young Cow and also</sup>

<sup>8<sup>th</sup> Give unto my Daughter Catharine Scott a negro girl called Paty</sup>

I give it to her and her heirs for ever.

<sup>9<sup>th</sup> Give unto my Daughter Sarah Scott my Plantation lying on  
Dowall Swamp adjoining to Hutchings & Gale with all Land  
belonging to it I give it to her & her heirs for ever  
and also I give her a negro boy Called Dicks to her & her heirs  
for ever it is also my will that my Daughter Sarah & my Daughter  
Catharine shall have their Liberty & prevelidge in the  
house and Plantation During the time they live single</sup>

<sup>10<sup>th</sup> Give all & Remaining part of my Estate I give unto my Son  
Robert Scott & my Daughter Sarah & Daughter Catharine to  
be Equally Divided amongst them three also of three negroes  
that I leave with my wife after her Decease and all other thing what  
soever that belongs to my Estate it is my will it is Equally Divide  
between my three Children aforesd Robert Sarah & Catharine  
and I Do appoint & ordain my Son Robert & my Daughter Sarah  
to be my sole Executor & Executrix to see this my last will and  
Testament performed and Ended and this I own to be my last  
will and testament Renouncing and Revoking all other wills  
or Execrments made by me as Witness my hand and Seal the 5<sup>th</sup></sup>

Day of September 1756
