I Comitt my self into the hands of Almighty God into his hands — through the Merits of Jesus Christ to obtain Everlasting life and for my — Worl^{dly} Estate as Goods Chattels and Lands I do give and bequeath as follo^w —
I give and bequeath my Land att Black Water that I bought of John Beam
being two hundred and fifteen acres to my son Rich^t Wells and his heirs
for ever but in Case of Mortallity of my son Rich^t then to my young^t
son J^r Wells and his heirs for ever and after to the survivors of them —
and thence here for ever

And for the Remaider of my Estate I give wholly and solely to my
Wife My Wif^r Mary Thomas Wells William Wells by name of my
Son Matthew Richers and Eliz^t heras their part and I do appoint my
Wife Mary Wells and Thomas Wells my Ex^r of this my last Will and
testament at witness my hand the 6th day of June 1713
