Green to Divide the Same according to the Quality thereof and I do Nominate and appoint my Loving Wife Mary Smith and my Couson Joseph Smith to be my Executors to See this my Will performed as Witness my hand this 5th of May 1718

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Wiles the third best feather bed and one post.

I give and bequeath unto my Son Moses Wiles one tankard and one pewter basin and one pewter Dish.

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Wiles three pounds Silver and as for all of Remains part of my Estate both with in and without of What nature or Quality soever I give to be Equally Divided between my Loving Wife Dorothy Wiles my Daughters Mary Wiles Sarah Wiles Ann Wiles and my Son & Moses Wiles according to of kind there of and do Request Joseph Smith Wm Weston & Joseph Weston to Divide the same according to Quality thereof and I do nominate and appoint my Loving Wife Dorothy Wiles and my Son Joseph Wiles to be my Executors to see this my will performed as Witness my hand this 14th of May 1712
