Prior together equally as long as my wife lives & after
her decease to be equally divided between them my children
Anna Prior & Jeremiah Prior & I doe make my wellbelov'd
wife Mary Prior ^{my} whole & sole Exor.^r of this my last will &
Testament, as Witness my hand & seal this 28 day of May
in ye year of our Lord 1689.
