Item I give Elizabeth Mungor the Daughter of John Mungor a Cowe calfe /
Item I give to Elizabeth Daines the Daughter of John Daines deceased, a Cowe calfe /
Item my will is, that all the Legacies above expressed be paid in order & wth the first convenient

Item I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Boucher, all my land housefurne, goods & chattells, moveables or
immovables, or debts of, what Nature or qualitie so ever they be: or whosoever they shall remaine
or be found, to her & her heirs for ever, And in case of the death of my said Daughter, Elizabeth
before this marry or attaine to be possesse, of my said estate, I give my land in case of her death
to my kinsman Robert Boucher, And all the remainder of my whole estate, I give to be equally
divided amongst the grand children, of my loving wife Elizabeth Boucher deceased And doe
request my loving friends, John Hardy & Thomas Talbot to be my overseers And in the behalf
of my said Daughter Elizabeth Boucher to be executor of this my last will & Testament: And further I doe
give my said overseers, as a remembrance of my last love, twenty shillings a piece, confirminge
this to be my last will & Testament: with my hand & seale, the day & year above written /
and sealed sealed & delivred in presence of us /
