 I bequeath my soule to the hands of almighty God my heavenly father by whom of his mercie and only grace I trust to be saved and receive into Eternal rest through the death of my saviour and Redeemer Jesus Christ in whose precious blood I with the whole and only hope of my saluation my body in hope of a joyfull resurrection I doe commit to the earth to be buried in decent manner at the discretion of my loving wife as for such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bestow on me with all in this life I doe give devise and bequeath and dispose of in manner and forme following
 I doe give and bequeath unto my servant man Henry Jutte a parcell of land beginning at my Cor next to me in George Hardys line for running for running downe my land to a Corners tree near Dautners branch to a Corners tree for running alonge the hedge row to the first station it being about eighty acres more or lesse to be enjoyed by the said Henry Jutte for the term of his natural life to begin one year after my decease
 I doe give and bequeath unto Edward Bichmo the son of George Bichmo and Mary his wife a parcell of land beginning at Robert Ellys Corners tree and for running alonge the line according to the course of my parcell unto my George Hardys line for running alonge the hedge row thence to the first station it being about two hundred and fifty acres of land to be enjoyed by the said Henry Jutte for the term of his natural life to begin one year after my decease

give unto him and the heirs of his body lawfully begotten for ever and if he should happen to die
 with out issue do then give the same unto his two sisters and the heirs of their bodies lawfully begotten
 the said land and not to be in his or their possessions until their grand children be dead
 do give and bequeath unto Elizabeth Putridge the daughter of Capt John Putridge and her heirs
 all and singular the rest and residue of my lands not before disposed of to be enjoyed by her and the
 heirs of her body lawfully begotten for ever and if it should so happen that she should die with
 out issue or heirs then do give the same unto her two sisters Honor and Constant and the
 heirs of their bodies lawfully begotten the said land to be enjoyed by the said Elizabeth Honor and
 Constant after the decease of my loving wife
 do give and bequeath unto Elizabeth Putridge one feather bed and furniture (viz) bolster
 pillow blankets Blankets Rugs sheets Curtains & Mattress
 do give and bequeath unto my loving wife Mary Crisp all and singular my lands except what
 land given unto Henry Suber to be fully enjoyed by her during her natural life and after her
 decease to the persons before named; in this my last Will and testament do give unto her all and
 singular my personal Estate except what I have before disposed of and of this my last Will do
 not make and ordain my well beloved wife my full and whole executrix and who as she is a
 Suber in law now depending before the governor and Council at Newport in Rhode Island and any other
 it is my will and request to my loving wife that she may prosecute the same and not to let it
 fall if it should so happen that I should die before she be an end unto it
 do nominate Constitute and appoint my loving friends Capt John Putridge and Wm Evans out of this
 of this my last Will and testament and do give unto each of them a good sum of five hundred my
 shillings to be paid unto her by the said Putridge and annual all such other debts or former
 will or wills by me in any will before this time made ratifying and confirming this and not
 oblige to my last Will and testament in writing for what I have hereunto set my hand and
 Seal the day and year before written
