Crues of the Upper parish of the County of Wright being weak in body but of good and perfect me-
mory thanks be to God do make this my last will and Testament in manner and forme following: I first give
and bequeath my soule to the hands of almighty God my heavenly father by whom of his merits and
only grace I trust to be saved and receive into Eternal rest through the death of my Saviour and Redeemer
Jesus Christ in whose precious blood I see the whole and only hope of my salvation my body in hope of
a joyfull resurrection I do commit to the earth to be buried in decent manner at the direction of my
Loving wife as for such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bestow on me with all in this life
I do give devise and bequeath and dispose of in manner and forme following:
I do give and bequeath unto my servant man Henry Jukes a parcell of land beginning at my Cor next to me
in George Haysers line for running down my line to a corner tree near Dancovers branch
and down alonge neer Dancovers branch to a marked tree in front of Haysers line for the Haysers line
to a corner tree for alonge the Hedge row to the first station it being about eighty acres more or less
to be enjoyed by the said Henry Jukes for the term of his natural life to begin one year after my
death
I do give and bequeath unto Edward Beckmoe the son of George Beckmoe and Mary his wife a parcell of land
beginning at Robert Ellys corner tree and for running alonge the line according to the Court of my
patent unto my George Haysers line of trees called the Hedge row thence to front of Haysers corner tree
and down the line to the first station it being two hundred and fifty acres of more or less the said land I do give

give unto him and the heirs of his body lawfully begotten for ever and if he should so happen to die
 without issue do then give the same unto his two sisters and the heirs of their body lawfully begotten
 the said and not to them his or their possessions and the heirs and assigns of the said
 do give and bequeath unto Elizabeth Sutcliffe the daughter of Capt John Sutcliffe and eldest his wife
 all and singular the right and residue of my lands not before disposed of to be enjoyed by her and the
 heirs of her body lawfully begotten for ever and if it should so happen that she should die with
 out heirs or heirs then do give the same unto her two sisters the said and Constant and the
 heirs of their body lawfully begotten the said lands to be enjoyed by the said Elizabeth Horner and
 Constant after the estate of my loving wife
 do give and bequeath unto Elizabeth Sutcliffe one feather bed and furniture (viz) bolster
 without pillow betwix blankets Rugs Sticks Cushions & Mattress
 do give and bequeath unto my loving wife Mary Croft all and singular my lands except what
 land given unto Henry Suter to be fully enjoyed by her during her natural life and after her
 decease to the persons before named in this my last Will and testament do give unto her all and
 singular my personal Estate except what I have before disposed of and of this my last Will I
 do make and ordain my well beloved wife my full and whole executrix and what as there is
 due in law now depending before the Justices and Council at Westmst in Henry Moore and my self
 it is my will and request to my loving wife that she may prosecute the same and not to let it
 fall if it should so happen that I should die before that be an End put to it
 do nominate constitute and appoint my loving friends Capt John Sutcliffe and Wm Evers out of
 of this my last Will and testament and do give unto each of them a fourth part of first and twenty
 shillings yearly and do hereby utterly disavow revoke and annul all such last wills or former
 will or wills by me in any wise before this time made ratifying and confirming this and no
 other to be my last Will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
 Seal the day and year before written
