 possess or shall have this I have given and bequeath unto my son John Bond
 fourthly only I have given out of my estate unto John Farmer all my wife's clothing both linen and woolen
 and I have appointed John Bell my wife's brother to be my whole and sole executor of this my last
 & Testament and it is my will that John Bell should live and abide upon my plantation with
 my two children my wife and my own and to bring them up with my estate to the end of their
 shall please god that my son John Bond should live with out issue then all my estate and my lands all that I shall have
 and William Manyard with out issue then all my estate and my lands all that I shall have
 John Bell my executor and his heirs for ever and it is my will that John Farmer should continue
 my house with my two children with my executor so long as he shall see fitting this being my last
 Will and Testament as Witness my hand and seal this 15th day of february 1687
