body to the earth to be buryed, & my worldly goods as followeth
I give unto my son John Prior the whole pence.
I give to my son Ruben Prior the fourth parts
of all my pence after my wife decease, & I give him
the biggest of my Potts after her decease.
And for all the rest of my estate I give & bequeath unto my
wife & to my daughter Anna Prior & to my son Josiah
Prior together equally as long as my wife lives & after
her decease to be equally divided between them my children
Anna Prior & Josiah Prior & I doe make my wellbelov'd
wife Mary Prior ^{my} whole & sole Exor.^r of this my last will &
Testament, as Witness my hand & seal this 28 day of May
in ye year of our Lord 1689.

In the name of God Amen I John Firzoll of the upper part
of the Isle of Wight County being sicke & weak of body
but sound of minde, & knowing the certainty of Death &
the uncertainty when to dye doe make this my last will &
Testament, giving & bequeathing as followeth. I give my soule
to God y^t I may live in hope of a blessed resurrection, & my
body to the earth to be buryed after a Christian manner & as
for

for my worldly goods I give as followeth. Item I give
 bynath unto my son William ffirzoll a parcell of
 Land in the lower parish of the Isle of Wight County
 lying upon a parcell of Land of Will ffirzoll's land, &
 lying upon fott Smith's & Richd Reynolds which land
 I give my said son Will for ever to him & his heirs
 I give my son Will ffirzoll my house bridle & saddle
 pistols, & holsters & sword & gun. I doe give my 1st son
 Will ffirzoll one feather bed & bolster Rugg & blanket
 & shooter. I give to my 1st son Will ffirzoll one brass
 kelle of nine gallons & two pewter dishes & two pewter
 plates, & one cew, & one heifer & one chrest. & one ewe,
 I give my son William ffirzoll one long table, if my son
 William ffirzoll dye before he come of age, then what I
 have given him to be equally divided between the rest of
 my children. I give unto my daughter Susanna-
 ffirzoll one feather bed bolster Rugg Blankett &
 shooter two pewter dishes, two pewter plates, one
 brass pott about 5 gall, a pewter candlestick & one
 pewter Mugg. — I give to my daughter Susanna-
 ffirzoll one cow. One heifer & one ewe, & one table, & one
 chrest. — I give unto my daughter Mary ffirzoll one
 feather bed bolster Rugg blanket & shooter & two pewter dishes
 two pewter plates, one pewter tankard one pewter tumbler
 one Iron pott about 5 gall. One chrest, one cow, one heifer
 one ewe. I give to my daughter Elizabeth ffirzoll three
 Steares to purchase her one feather bed with furniture, —
 the one steare about 3 yeares old, y^e other 4, the other 5 —
 yeares old, I give my daughter Eliz^a two pewter dishes, two
 pewter plates, one brass skimmer, one pewter tumbler —
 one Iron pott about 3 gall. One chrest, one cow, one heifer,
 one ewe, And I doe make my wellbelov'd wife Susanna

Some tym^e in May 1693 wee the subscribers being examined &
Sworn, saith, that being at y^e house of Antho. Croker, he there
being very sick, but in y^e full & sound memory to y^e Judgem^t
desired us to take notice of what he there said as toward his will.
He gave two h^{ds} of Cattell apiece to his four children he had by his
wife then living, and he gave also the forer^r children that Rob^t
Croker, W^m Croker, Mary Croker, a Mary a spare, Son Edrd Croker
he gave his bed that he commonly layd on, & further he gave to
his son Rob^t Croker, and W^m Croker his two Loomes, & all the
appurtenances, belonging, and y^e Remainder to his loving wife
Mary Croker and further saith not
aug^t the 9th 1693.

The last will and Testam^t of Thomas Williams Sm^r.

First, I bequeath my soul, into y^e hands of God, my Heavenly Father
the Creator thereof, trusting y^e through y^e merits of my Blessed
Saviour, Jesus Christ to receive y^e reward for all my sins. And for my
worldly estate I bequeath as followeth,
first two hundred acres of Land, called the Reddy branch offeased of
of George Perri, one hundred I give to my son John Williams, the
other hundred to my son Richard Williams & to my son Thomas I give
my Gun, my son Rich^d to have the plantation that is now seated, in his
hundred Acres of Land: this Land whereon I live, I give one half
