

In the Name of God almighty, Gracious & Merciful, I John Bond of the City of Newgate in
Virginia, Gentleman fidele & weake in body, but of sounde & perfect memorie, prays & glorieth to have
to you do: this sixteenth day of January, 1668 make & ordaine this my last will & testament as
followeth: First I bequeath my soule to God that gave it me: And fasse his blessegnes that
through the mercies of Jesus Christ my Savio: I shall haue remission of my sinnes, and that
I shall rise againe at the last day, amoungst the electe & chosen of God, and as for my body
I bequeath to the earth from whence it came, wch Christian burials and what worldly
estate it hath pleased God to bestow upon me, my just debts, beinge paid I give & bequeath
as followeth: First I give & bequeath unto my sonne: William Bond th: Plantation
wherewon I live, And all the land therunto belonging, inludinge all the Woods & pastures
extendinge to Edward Hinde's boundes foringe, Also: I give to my sonne: John Bond all the
plantation wherewon Edward Hinde son new built and all the land to that, or therunto
belonging, inludinge all the woodland grounde on the other side of the Swampe brooke
to the hill of Sab, the bounds except. I give to my two sonnes William & John
Bond, one breeding Marre, & the other wch to go equally betwixt them, and if either of my
sonnes should die, then for the Marre & her mariage to go to the furthest, and I give to my
two sonnes, each of them two pounds. Also: I give & bequeath to my daughter Frances
Bond wife: Dorothy Bond whome I make, & appoint, my whole executors
of this my last will & testam: And do: hereby declare, all wills made by me done, and done
before me, Also: my desire is, that my Marre Cattell be sold to satisfie my debts, Also: my will
& pleasure is, that my wife, haue th: benefit of all my lands, duringe her naturall life, and
as for the rest of my estate as cattle horse, hoggs & all else, that do: belongeth unto me, I give
unto my louing wife, Dorothy Bond whome I make, & appoint, my whole executors
of this my last will & testam: And do: hereby declare, all wills made by me done, and done
before me, Also: I make this my last will & testam: written unto Ith: son John Bond
the testator hath written set my hande & seal, the day & year above written, and also: I do
request, ordaine, & appoint these my louing friends as followeth, Capt: Francis England, Lt: Arthur
Smith & m: Richard Sharp to be executors of this my last will & testam:
