

In the Name of God Amen Gracious & Merciful, I John Bond of the Shire of Northampton in
 England Gent: becomge sick & weak in body, but of sound & perfect memory, prays & glory be given
 to God, do: this fiftenth day of January, 1662 make & ordaine this my last will & Testament as
 followeth. First I bequith my soule to God that gave it me, sheweth this becomge that
 through the meritts of Jesus Christ my Saviour. I shall have remission of my sinnes, and that
 I shall rise againe att the last day, amongst the elect & chosen of God, And as for my Body
 I bequith to the earth from whence it came wth Christian buriall And what worldly
 estate it hath please god to bestow upon me, my just debts becomge paid I give & bequith
 as followeth. First I give & bequith unto my sonn: William Bond the Plantation
 whereon I live, And all the land therunto belonging, including all the tithes & profits
 extending to Edward Hurstons Spring, Also I give to my sonn: John Bond all the
 plantation whereon Edward Hurston now liveth And all the land to that, or therunto
 belonging, including all the woodland ground, on the other side of the Swamp Chording
 to the bill of Sab, the boundes express, I give unto my two sonn: William & John
 Bond, one becomge Mars, & his wife, to go: equally betwixt them, And if either of my
 sonn: should dye, Then for the Mars & his wife, to go: to the survivor: And I give unto my
 two sonn: each of them two Cows. Also I give & bequith to my daughter Frances
 Bond six: pound wth thier interest, Also I give unto her the best bed & furniture that is in
 my house, to be delivered her att her day of marriage, And halfe my household furniture
 becomge, Also my desire is, That my Maie: shall be bound to satisfy my debts, Also my will
 & pleasure is, that my wife, have the benefit, of all my lands, during her Natural life, And
 as for the rest of my estate, as cattle horse, hoggs & all else, that do: belong unto me I give
 unto my loving wife, Dorothy Bond whom I make, & appoint, my whole & sole executrix
 of this my last will & Testament: And do: hereby revoke, all wills & deeds by me don And do
 ratify & establish & confirm: this to be my last will & Testament: wherunto I the said John Bond
 the Testator: hath herunto sett my hand & seal, the day & year above written And also: I do
 request, ordaine & appoint that my loving friends as followeth, (vizt) Francis England Esq: Arthur
 Smith & Mr: Anthony Sharpe to be overseers of this my last will
