

I John Graue doe hereby acknowledge this to be my last Will and Testament and doe make John Murry my Executor and the twenty pounds sterling obligation of Arthur Allens due to me I give out of this sum to be paid forthwith John Murry ten pounds and to Thomas Powell five pounds and all my Books and papers and medicines and gally pots and glass bottles and the other things pounds to the repairing of our meeting house on my next feast also out of my linen in my house I give my fine linen Calico Holland to Elizabeth Murry and to Susan Bristle my Gouerning and to Samuel Newton six Ells of Dowlat and to John Harris I give twelve yards of black tithing and a pair of new blankets and six Ells of Dowlat and two of my best wearing Coats and to Peter Ginn I give three white coats and two shirts of the new stuff also I doe acquit all debts due to me here in Virginia either by bill or account of every person except the of our said Arthur Allens twenty pounds and that I give as before mentioned also out of my money in my house I give to William Richards ten shillings and to John Lee five shillings and to John Murry his three sons John William George each of them half a crown and all the remainder of my money in my house I give to my Executor John Murry more half I give to William Richards two of my best wearing stuff Coats and six Ells of Dowlat and to Sara Miller I give four yards of serge and three Ells of Dowlat I doe earnestly desire of the Court that not doubting I should be good to any about any concerning things of this my Will having desired Thomas Powell to send a Copie of this my Will and to whom I doe give my money in England which I owe to be about sixty pounds that is forty pounds to my sisters Anne Waltons potters and the remainder to my Nephew Peter Ginn and to Peter Ginn's afore said I give to him and his wife six Ells of Dowlat and six Ells of Canvas and to the same John Lewis my dear Gouerning I give White my hand and seal this tenth of the tenth month 1689

I Thomas Pope being in perfect health and memory blessed be almighty God for it hath made this my last Will and Testament first I bequeath my ^{duelty} soul to God who gave it me Secondly I bequeath my body to the Earth from whence it came to be buried in decent manner and for my worldly goods I give as followeth first I give to my sons Robert Pope and William Pope one half of land which is already lay down for them Joyning upon William Bodini and so to the young Branch Joyning to my own plantation which land is divided between them already for them and their heirs for ever I give to my daughter Joyce two cows to be delivered to her when she is married I give to my daughter Mary Pope one cow and cow Lardner which was given to her by her godfather and she is married from this time forth she demands them I give to George Goddard one hundred acres breadth of land beginning at a corner tree at the Elms Swamp and run north and south with to my last path I give to my sons John Pope and Thomas Pope all the rest of my lands to be divided equally between them for them and their heirs for ever only I will that my wife Joyce Pope have her thirds out of it so long as she lives and for all the rest of my Estate both within and without I give to my wife Joyce Pope and my two sons John and Thomas Pope to be divided equally between them I will that my son Thomas Pope be my sole Executor of all my Estate after my decease I give with that all this about said land which I have given shall for them and their heirs for ever and from heirs to heirs none of it shall ever be sold but remaine from one to another and for the true performance hereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty fourth day of Sept^r 1684
