

Isle of Wight, In y name of God Amen, I John Jones being desirous to set in writing my last Will & Testament in manner & forme as followeth, first I do exhort my soul unto y hand of Almighty God my maker, trusting through y meritorious death of Jesus Christ my Saviour to receive pardon for y selfe of all my sins and for my body to be buried at y discretion of my Executor hereafter nominated.

And as for my worldly goods I give as followeth,

I give unto my sonne Abraham Jones Six hundred Acres of Land lying in y upper parish of Blackwater to him & to his Heires for ever lawfully begotten, also I give him one Heirloom, one hugg & one pair of Blanketts, & one young Mord, & one Gunne & my Sword & Belt

I give unto my daughter Anna & wife of Dr Barnes, one hundred & fifty acres of Land att Blackwater lying on neare William Brambles, y breadth on y Swamp and the long side y outer byne, y said Land to have during her life & after her deaue, I give it to her sonne John Barnes to him & to his Heires for ever lawfully begotten, and if he shalldye w/out leving any such heire, then to my daughters neefold & sister y Survivor, and if my daughter shalld have no children live to have any such heire, then y Land to fall to my sonne Abraham & to his Heires lawfully begotten, The plantation & Land w/out London I leave & give to my living wife during her life & after her deaue to my sonne Abraham also to her Heires for ever lawfully begotten, and two hundred acres of Land lying in the ^{Lower} part of Barnes to my wife deposing to doe as she pleases w/ it, and as for my personall Estate only w/ I want given to my sonne Abraham, and Twelve pound I give to my sonne John Jones, I give to my living wife Anna Jones, also payeing my debts out of it, and I leave to my sole Executrix to suffice this my Will, but if my sonne Abraham shall dye w/out lawfull Heire then my Will is that the Land I give him shall fall to my daughter and to her Heires for ever lawfully begotten, as witness my hand & seal this 20th day of July 1697
