In the Name of God Amen, I Rebecca Izard being sick in bed, but of sound & full memory, do make this my last, will & testament: Inasmuch I bequeath my soul, unto the Almighty God, trusting through the Merits of my Saviour Jesus Christ to inherit eternall life, my body I bequeath unto the earth to be buried in a decent manner, & for my worldly estate I bequeath as followeth

My will is; that After my Daughter Rebecca Bagnall, shall be taken out of the which estate, of mine, and
my Daughter Martha, shall be the sixth part, then the estate, to be equally divided, between me, and my aforesaid
Daughter Martha, shall then out of my proportion, I give & bequeath as follows

I have unto Elizabeth Bagnall, & Mary Binnell, & Martha Good, & James Bagnall the sonne of James Bagnall, Nicholas
Hunt, the sonne of George Hunt, & Elizabeth Lewis, the daughter of Henry Lewis, all my proportion of estate &
before expressed, to be equally divided, & to be divided among them, And my will is, that my son James Bagnall, Henry Lewis
& Nicholas, & my executor, & his heirs my will performed, do both with & against me, I have hereunto set my hand
this fourteenth day of May 1675/
