Poole planter, in the upper parish of the Iff of night County, some what sick in body
but of good & perfect memory, thanks be therefore given unto the Almighty God, do
therefore make & ordain this my last will & testament in manner & form as followeth
That is to say. First & principally, I give & bequeath my soules into the hands of God my
Creator: husband & verie beloved: to receive pardon & remission, of all my sinnes by
Jesus Christ, And his death & passion my body I commit to the earth to be decently and
Christianlike buried And my worldly & personall estate, wherewith the Almighty God
hath endowed me I shall dispose of as followeth

In the first I give and bequeath unto my true loving wife, Elizabeth Poole all my personall
estate wherewith God hath endowed me: I shall And do by these presents make her wholly
& solely executrix after, but if it shall please God to take her the said Elizabeth out of his
life, without any issue of mine: Then the said estate to returne unto her only sonne: Edward
Champion. Item I give unto Thomas Blakes daughter one herfer called
M:abunmouth. I give & bequeath unto Elias fford Junr. one ralph the first that is fallen
I give unto the daughter of John Horis one ralph, I give unto Stephen Jonsen one cow
to be delivered when he cometh of age, of Sawntons, I also give unto Edward Champion
my sonne hum, it is my will that my wife sell his what debts may be justly claimed upon
by bill or promysse. I do also request, John Birt & Elias fford to do: their utmost
endeavour to see this my will performed in a reasonable manner, that the estate that I shall
leave be kind me: be not willfully waisted & ymbrazled. Signed sealed and delivered in

At Seminge place to Herod one cowe ralph for the use of Katherine Egborne my daughter, Given to you
his wife to my child her goddaughter by the female lineage to her & to her heirs being marked upon
flore: under the right eare & a hole in the same eare, as a signe & true shew in the left eare of a Crown
Gilted August 9th 1670

I confirm this gift unto the child in open Court held for the Iff of night County
