

In the name of God Amen, this nineteenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred and ninety, and in the twenty year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord and Lady William and Mary King and Queen of England Scotland France and Ireland defendours of the faith the Marmaduke Cherrisholme late of Virginia now resident in Charles Town in the County of Middlesex in England Christian being sick and weak and to take in body but of sound and perfect memory knoweth to almighty God, and knowing the uncertainty of this transitory life, and that all men must yett come to death when betwixt it shall please God to call, and being desirous to do all things in order do make and ordain and declare this my last Will and Testament in manner following, touching and by these presents admitting all former Wills and other Will and Wills Testaments and Testaments by me here to fore made either by word or writing, and this is to be taken only for my last Will and Testament and none other - And first I do Commit my soule into the hands of God my Creator, Saviour, only in the death and merits of Jesus Christ my Redeemer for Salvation my Body I Commit to be interred to be buried decently buried, at the discretion of my Executor hereafter named, and for that small Estate which God hath bene graciously pleased to bestow upon me I do dispose of as followeth Inprimis, my Will is, that all my Just debts which you are in duty or conscience to any person or persons whomsoever, shall well and truly pay, or ordain to be paid within convenient tyme within my decease by my Executor hereafter named, Item I do give and bequeath unto my good friend Bartholomew Greene of Charles Towne of one vault from whom I have received many other things and in manner all my Estate, of what nature or kind soever, whether real or personal and whosoever it is being, and in particular, all that legacy given and bequeath'd to me by the last Will and Testament of my Honored father, Thomas Cherrisholme late of Wakefield in your Majesty in the Kingdom of England Apothecary deceased to the said Bartholomew Greene most or left, to him the said Bartholomew Greene his heirs Executors, admors and assigns for ever and I do hereby make constitute appoint and declare the said Bartholomew Greene to be the sole Executor of this my Will in whatsoever wherof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year first above written
