my last Will & Testament.

first I bequeath my Soule to Almighty God who gave it me
secondly, I bequeath my Body to y^e Earth from whence it came
in hopes of a glorious Resurrection through y^e Merits of my
Saviour Iesus Christ

And for my worldly Estate I give in manner & forms following
first I give to my eldest Daughter ~~Francis~~ ^{Elizabeth} ~~Moyall~~ ^{three} pown
Dishes and six pown for porringers

next I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Moyall foure hundred pown
of tobacco, also I give to my ^{grand} Son Tho: Clarke one cow and my
great Bible

next I give to Eliz: Clarke my granddaughter one yearling heifer

next I give to my Son John Ponny one feather bed, boat stor and
one pillow, and bedstead, curtains and vallains and one shag Rugg
and a set of Blanketts and one great Chest

next I give unto my Grandson Rich: Ponny one cow, and also to my Gran-
daughter Mary Ponny y^e Daughter of ~~Thomas~~ ^{John} Ponny, one yearling
heifer, also I give to my granddaughter, Mary Ponny daughter
of Will: Ponny, one silver drum cup, and one cow y^e is called
mobbye farr, and likewise I give to Elizabeth Ponny Daughter of
Will: Ponny one yearling heifer

next I give to my Son Will: Ponny two cows and one calf, and two
boards off fourt year old, these cattle being at Will: Ponny's
already, and likewise I give to Mary Ponny y^e Daughter of
Will: Ponny, one pown for tankard

next I give to my Daughter Mary Marshall wife of Rob: Marshall
that piece of Land, y^e given by y^e Name of Ponny's pines, which
Rob: Marshall hath a Lease for, and if there be not fifty acres
of it, as it is bound by y^e Lease, I doe give her so much for my
upon it as will make it fifty Acres, to her and her heirs, y^e sh^e
hath by y^e afores: Rob: Marshall for ever, with all his fitts
and privileges therunto belonging, I doe freely alienate it
from me and my heirs for ever.

next I give unto my Grandson Rich: Gray one cow.

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Next I give unto my Eldest Son with Penny, all y^e Rest of my Land
which I now have in my possession, unto him, my Eldest Son with Penny,
and to y^e heire Male of his body Lawfully begotten for ever, and if it should
please God my Son with Penny should dye without any Male heire, then it is
my Will, that then this my Land shall fall, to my Son John Penny,
and to his heire Male Lawfully begotten of his body, and if it should please
God, to take my Son In: Penny out of this Life, and his Male heire die
without Issue Male Lawfully begotten of his body, then it is my Will
that this my Land, shall fall to my Daughter Mary Mars hall during
the tyme of her Naturall Life, and after her Decease, it is my Will
that it shall fall to y^e next of my kindred

NEXT, I give to my Son in Law Rob: Marshall, after my deap^{er}
and prayd, all my whole Estate both within & without, Except
what is before given, by this my Will, and Do appoint & ordaine
my Son in Law Rob: Marshall my Sole Ex^{or} of this my last Will
and Testament, Revoking and making void, all former Wills -
and Testam^{ts}: as witness to my hand and Seale this fourteenth
day of April 1693
