 my body to the earth whome it was taken to be buried in such distant & Christian manner
 as to my Executors hereafter named shall be thought meet and convenient: and as touching
 such worldly Estate as the Lord in mercy hath lent me my Will and meaning is the same
 shall be employed and bestowed as hereafter by this my Will is expressed: and first I do renounce
 frustrate and make void all Wills by me formerly made, and declare and appoint this to be
 my last Will and Testament: Item I do give devise and bequeath unto my four grand-
 daughters being the daughters of Timothy Spence & Elizabeth his wife two several Tracts with
 their furniture: and for all the rest of my Estate what soever, or whosoever both real
 and personal I do give devise and bequeath the same unto my son Robert Lee
 and I do make and ordain him to be my sole Executor in Witness whereof I have here-
 unto put my hand and seal the day year and Reign above Written
