

In the Name of God Amen this 2^d of Sept. 1696 I Tho. Moore of York
 Wright being Disposed in Body but in Sound and perfect mind and memory, do make
 this my last will & Testament: in writing as followeth. Viz. first I recommend my
 soul into y^e hands of God who gave it trusting by y^e Merits of my Saviour Christ
 to attain to y^e Resurrection of life. My Body to be decently buried at y^e discretion
 of my Ex^{rs}. hereafter named, and for such worldly Estate as God has bestowed on
 with I give as followeth. I give to Edward Champion Jun^r. my land &
 bought of Edw. Cobb to hold to him and his heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath
 to Orlando Champion all my land on y^e West side of y^e Black water Swamp, being
 pt of a patent of four hundred Acres lying between John Clark & John Atkins
 to hold to him and his heirs for ever, the s^d. several lands to be for y^e use of Edw.
 Champion. Now Father of them y^e. Edw. & Orlando, both they shall severally
 attain to age of one and twenty years, And in case either of them shall die
 before they attain y^e age of one and twenty years or without skill & dis-
 cretion, the s^d. several lands to be sold, and y^e proceeds thereof bequeath the same to the heirs
 of me the Testator. Item I give and bequeath to Alice Champion daughter of Edw.
 Champion, one feather bed & bolster & pillow & of Blankets & a new rug bedstead
 & curtains as they now stand called my bed. Item I give and bequeath unto Benjⁿ.
 Champion son of Edward Champion my Negro boy called Toby and to Orlando
 Champion son of s^d. Edw. my Negro boy called Mingo the s^d. Negroes to be
 returned to me when they shall attain y^e age of one & twenty, and in y^e mean-
 time to be at y^e use & dispose of Edw. Champion father to y^e. Benjamin
 and Orlando. Item I give unto my lo. wife the s^d. Moore. My Negro woman called
 Charis Chapman one thousand pounds of Tobacco in trust y^e s^d. same to be justly
 layd out for y^e cloathes and furnish of my Noire. Magdalen Carter for cloathes
 and other necessaries as they shall see fitting. And I do likewise give one thousand
 pounds of Tobacco to y^e. s^d. brother for y^e sole use of Precilla Champion In
 about written, and I do appoint my wife and my Brother Ex^{rs}. as my will & in
 Charles Chapman & m^r. Carrill ever for
 Signed sealed and subscribed
 at his last will & Testament in
 presence of
 Tho. Moore Seal
