 I becomitt my body unto God, from whence it was taken, in full & certain hope of joyful
 resurrection, through Christ my redeemer when it shall please God to call for me: & my soul whis
 immortal & death not up my body: I becomitt unto God that gave it me: when it shall please God to call
 me: out of this world And for my worldly goods: which it hath pleased God to bestow upon me: I becomitt
 & dispose of in manner as followeth: I give & bequeath unto my son: Thomas Whittly two hundred
 acres of land, that I bought of Capt. Fulgham & my Brother William Godwin, to give him assurance
 of the same: all that, my son: land to be as good in quantity & quality, as my Brother William
 gave also: unto my son: Thomas, when he cometh to age: of twenty one: years, five thousand pounds
 of the: & cash, And he to be brought up to learning: as readings, writings & reckonings of account
 when capable thereof, & in case of default of the said: learning, then to pay him eight thousand pounds
 of the: & cash, I also: give & bequeath, unto my daughter, to pay after administration one: acre: unto Thomas
