I Thomas Laborer of the C^{ty} of Wright County in
Virginia being in health and memory Did make and
ordayned this my Last Will & Testament with my
owne hand writing this 24 day of Jan^y 1692.
in manner and form as followeth Vizt I Comitt my soule
into the hands of allmighty God my Creator, hoping
through the meritts of Jesus Christ to obtaine ever
Lasting life and for my Estate, Lands Goods and Chatties
I Doe bequeath Each as followeth Vizt - -
I Doe Give and bequeath my Land of now Land upon
with all and singular y^e houses, fences and orchards
with what so Ever else is y^e said Land man^ynt.
being four hundred acres, doth appoyntayne one before
being Commonly Called Bagerer (Rypp) unto Joseph Cipolani
my Grand son for Ever and to his heirs male or female
for Ever but if my s^d Grandson Joseph Cipolani should
turne over

I give with out shew male or female, then my will is
that my Land grow live upon Calod Basse Choye shall
be Lived & enjoyed by my will by my Grandson Thomas
numan if son of John numan and my Daughter Ruth
and his heirs for ever male or female - - -

I Give and bequeath to my Grandson Thomas wrobb
the son of William and my Daughter Mary wrobb my
Land of bought of Charles Edwards, which John Bodgod
now lieth upon Contayning three outts with house
and orchard and other appertinants there unto belonging
to him and his heirs for ever -

my will is that all my household Goods and other
Goods all of what nature or kind soever in my house
on house here or in England, be Divided into five
parts viz - To my Daughter human's Children to my
Daughter Mary wrobb's Children, to my Daughter
Christian's ^{to my daughter Elizabeth Copeland's Children} Children, and to Elizabeth wrobb's Children
Except my wearing apperrell both Linen & wollen
all which I bequeath to my son John numan, I give
and bequeath to my Daughter Ruth one feather bed
furnished as the now stand, and to my Daughter
Mary wrobb of feather bed furnished as it now is, and to my
Grandaughter Christian Jordan a feather bed as it is
now standing and to my Grandson Joseph Copeland
a feather bed of Ly upon usually, and to Thomas wrobb
I Give a feather bed in the shed as it is there standing
which feather bed with sheets & covering good give
and bequeath as it is, and to have their Choyse as
to precedence as if have have set them downe -
I Give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary wrobb
my horse called Sparke, and for the rest of my horse
maner shooes and Catell, I Do Give & bequeath
them to my Daughter Ruth numan and her

Children by John numan and to my Daughter
Christians Children, and to my Daughter Elizabeth
Coplands Children to be Equally Divided into three
Parts to Each of the three ffamylias a parte, & I
Do Leave my Estate to my son John numan rent
free to Enjoy it with out Interruption untill, my
Grandson Joseph Copland Come to age to Enjoy it to
make noo wast upon it and keep Joseph to serve at
His owne Charge til he can wright and sypther sypthion
and my will is that what Com. and promision I have
Lied into my hows to share front, to mayntain
those I Leave upon my plantation this present year
and for my hoggs in Generall of Gint and bequeath
them all to y^e mayntainance of hows and family
I have played there upon my plantation after my
Decease I Desire all my debts may be paid in the
first place and then the Remainder to be Divided
according to my will, and I Do here by Rounke
all former wills by me made ordan, and nominate
appoint and make my Grandson Joseph Copland
my whole and sole Executor of this my last will
and Testament Confirming it with my hand
and Seale the Day and year first written
