First, I bequeath my soul, into y^e hands of God, my Heavenly Father
the Creator thereof, trusting y^e through y^e merits of my Blessed
Saviour, Jesus Christ to receive y^e reward for all my sins. And for my
worldly Estate I bequeath as followeth,
first two hundred acres of Land, called the Reddy branch offeased of
of George Perri, one hundred I give to my son John Williams, the
other hundred to my son Richard Williams & to my son Thomas I give
my Gun, my son Rich^d to have the plantation that is now seated, in his
hundred Acres of Land: this Land whereon I live, I give one half

share wherupon shon lived, after my Lo: wife's Natural Life, I give unto

Brazey. To my Daughter Mary I give two Cowes and calves, and to my Daugh
Ann I give two Cowes and calves, when they come to be married, or eight
= one year to be divided to them. The Rest of my Cattle and all my
household goods, I give to my Lo: wife, ^{and the two young children to be divided} for y^e good
of y^e plantation, the Cattle and household goods, to be divided when my
wife dyeth, or the children Rich: and Arth: come to Age, Also my
two sons John & Thomas, to see this my will. fulfilled, as witness
my hand y^e day and year above written.
