 in the Sole County being at present Sick and weak in body but perfect in
 Sense and memory Calling to mind that it is ones appointed for all men to
 die think fit to make and publish this my last will & Testimony wherein
 I give and bequeath my Land and other Estate which it hath pleased the
 mighty God to bestow on me in manner and form as followeth first
 I bequeath my soul to God that Give it & my body to the Earth to be
 buried in a Christian like manner I leave to my son Abraham by me
 the plantation that I dwell on with all the Land thereunto belonging
 and my fiddle and one feather bed and furniture and one Gun one Chest
 and four pewter Dishes three plates and my Negro Mance 11 I leave
 to my son William Joyner This soon pounds in money and my Spile &
 all that doth belong to it and four pewter dishes and three plates
 and one feather bed and furniture and one Gun and one Chest and
 one Grindstone and my Negro Child I leave to my Daughter Elizabeth
 Joyner One feather bed and furniture and four pewter dishes and three
 plates and one Iron pot and one Trunk and to receive them at the age
 of Eighteen - - - I leave to my Daughter Sarah Joyner One feather bed
 and furniture and the remaining part of my pewter and one Trunk
