 my body I commit to the ground to be decently buried by my  
 Executor hereafter named

Here I give unto my loving friend John Gum the plantation whereon  
 I now live and all the Land thereunto belonging to him the said  
 John Gum and his Heirs forever I give unto the said John Gum  
 two Negro Children by name Sarah Rogers W<sup>m</sup> Rogers Thomas  
 both to serve the said John Gum or his Heirs until they come to  
 the age of Twenty one years and at the age of Twenty one years  
 to be free and at their disposing only they paying to the said John  
 Gum or his Heirs yearly thirty pounds of Tobacco each I give  
 unto John Gum one Negro woman called for him to serve the said  
 John Gum until her youngest child the said Peter comes to the age  
 of Twenty one years and then the said Negro woman to be free &  
 at her own disposing she paying the said John Gum thirty pounds  
 of Tobacco yearly

And all the rest of my Estate Goods & Chattles whatsoever I give  
 and bequeath unto my loving friend John Gum and his Heirs  
 forever And I do appoint my loving friend John Gum my sole &  
 sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament revoking disannulling  
 and making void all other Wills heretofore made by me In witness  
 whereof I have hereunto put my hand & Seal this 25 Day of  
 December 1726

In the name of God Amen The twenty eight day  
of November in the year of our Lord 1728 I Michale Fulligan of upper  
parish of the Isle of Wigtown County being very sick and weak in body but  
of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God therefore calling  
unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed  
for all men once to die do make and Ordain this my last Will & Testament  
That is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my Soul  
into the hands of God that gave it and for my body I recommend it to the  
earth to be buried in a Christian like & Decent manner at the discretion  
of my Executors nothing doubting but at the Generall resurrection I shall  
receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as touching such  
worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this Life I  
give Devise and Dispose of the same in the following manner and for  
after my Debts paid I give and bequeath to my Cousin John Fulligan  
to dishes and to Basons an to plates and a Cow an Calf and a heifer &  
Coat Jacket and Breeches

And I give to my Cousin John Williamson one Dish an one Basson  
and one plate and one Cow and I give and bequeath to my Sister Mary  
Fulligan what money I have and I give and bequeath to my Brother  
Edman Fulligan all my Cattle after the Legacies taken out and my  
Coarse Coat and my Gun and sword and I give unto my Brother John  
Fulligan my better Gun and I give and bequeath unto my Sister Mary  
Fulligan eight head of Cattle and all the rest of my Estate during her  
Life an then to my Brother Edman Fulligan whom I likewise constitute  
make and Ordain my only and sole Executor of this my last will &  
Testament all And I do hereby utterly disallow revoke & Disannul  
all & every other former Testament Will Legacies and Executors  
by me in any way before this time named Willed & bequeathed  
ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my Last Will and  
Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and  
Seal the day and year above Written
