and memory do make this my last will and testament in writing as follows
I recommend my soul to God that gave it me trusting by the merits of my
Saviour Christ to attain to the resurrection of life my body to be decently
buried at the discretion of my wife. ~

I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah David one negro man named
Peter to her and her heirs lawfully begotten of her body for ever.

I leave to my loving wife Sarah Hogges one negro woman named Jane during
her natural life after her death I Give the said negro woman to my Daugh-
ter Sarah David and her heirs lawfully begotten of her body for ever.

I leave to my loving wife Sarah Hogges one negro boy named Tom during
her natural life after her death I Give the said negro boy Tom to my Daugh-
ter Sarah David and her heirs lawfully begotten of her body for ever.

I Give to my Daughter Mary Hogges one negro woman named Juba and
all her increase to her and her heirs lawfully begotten of her body for ever.

I leave to my loving wife Sarah Hogges one negro man named Dick dur-
ing her natural life after her death I Give to my Daughter Mary Hogges
the said negro man named Dick to her and her heirs lawfully begotten
of her body for ever but if dying without heirs I Give the said negro man
to my Daughter Sarah David and her heirs lawfully begotten of her
body for ever.

I Give to my Daughter Mary Hogges my great trunk and all that is in it
to the Lock and Key.

I Give to my said Daughter Mary Hogges my best bed and furniture.

I Give to my said Daughter to one fifth and to one fourth and half an
Oz of new powder six lbs & half a doz of plated & silver of silver and two Tankards.

I Give that parcel and mortgag of land I now live upon to my Daughter
Mary Hogges and her heirs of her body lawfully begotten for ever.

I Give to my Daughter Mary Hogges ten head of cattle. ~

I leave all the remainder part of my Estate to be equally divided between my
wife and two Daughters making my loving wife Sarah Hogges my whole
sole & separate executrix my hand and seal.

Witness my hand and seal. Elias Hogges Seal
and sealed & delivered in the presence of John Goodrich, John Hogges.
