dear friends shall see fitting my worldly goods I give & bequeath in  
the manner & form following.

- Item. I give & bequeath to my son Joseph Bridger one great Iron pott and two  
large pewter dishes out of them having the coat of Arms on it and four  
newer plates.
- Item. I give and bequeath to my son Robert Bridger four pewter dishes  
and four pewter plates.
- Item. I give and bequeath to my son John Bridger the 600 shovels on with  
the kugg blanket and sheet & pillow case and bedsted and two pewter  
dishes and two of my best shovels.
- Item. I give & bequeath unto my daughter Hester Bridger the best suit of  
Curtains & valins out quilts & trink and my best and bedsted ~  
belong to the Curtains.
- Item. I give all my old Lumber in my house as old chests, Tables, Chair  
and the like to be equally divided between my two daughters Hester  
Bridger and Elizabeth Bridger and all my provision as Corn wheat  
and meat I like w<sup>ise</sup> give to my two daughters Hester Bridger &  
Elizabeth Bridger by writing one of my Hattling Hogg and ten at  
give to my son John Bridger and what how Hogg I have against a  
noter year I like w<sup>ise</sup> give to my two daughters Hester and  
Elizabeth.

I leave my old Horse stall for the plantation use.

I give to my two Daughters one bridled Stear for best another year and all the rest of my Cattle and Sheep I give to be equally divided between my two Sons Robert & John and my two Daughters Hester & Elizabeth and the wheat that is on the Ground I likewise give between the same four Robert, John Hester & Elizabeth. I will that what wheat I owe be paid out of the House before my death. I make my two Sons Robert & John my whole Executors to see this my last will and Testament performed as witness my Hand this 24<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord 1727. ~ Elizabeth Bridger
