and testament committing my soul to God my Creator and my body to
the earth to be buried by my Executors and Executors hereafter named
and for what goods & estate it had possessed God to dispose of in
S^c of wig & bequeath in manner & form as follows to wit

- Item I give unto my daughter Frances Sanderson wife of Jonathan
Sanderson one shilling to be paid her by my Executors & Executors
hereafter named.
- Item I give unto my daughter Lucretia Turner wife of Th^s Turner
one shilling to be paid her by my Executors & Executors hereafter named.
- Item I leave unto my dear & loving wife Lucretia Segrave all my
estate in land and out doors during her widow hood but if she
marry it is my desire that she shall only have an equal share
with my son William Segrave, Elizabeth Segrave
Frances and Ann & Susannah & Sarah but in case she dye with
out marrying it is my desire that my Children above named to
wit William, Elizabeth, Frances, Ann, Susannah, & Sarah shall
have all my whole estate divided among them.
- Item I also constitute and appoint my dear & well beloved wife Lucretia
and my son William Segrave to be my whole & sole Executors & Executors to
this my last will & testament which I ratify & confirm renouncing all
other wills & testaments formerly made by me & give under my hand
& seal this 2^d day of Oct^r in the year of our Lord 1725.
