Item. Provides my Son Michael Brey shall stay and abide with me
and my wife during our natural lives then my plantation and all
the rest of my lands I give to him and his heirs for ever.

I do give all the rest of my Estate I give to my said son Michael to enjoy for
ever except two pounds shillings to my Daughter Susanah with make &
nominate and appoint my loving son Michael to enjoy to be my whole &
sole Executor of this my last will and Testament as witness my hand & seal
this 30th day of the Countess month called December 1725 my son Thomas

and two Daughters to be equally divided among them.

I do appoint my son John Godin my whole full Executor of this my
last will and Testament as witness my hand & seal this 4th day of February
in the Year of our Lord God 1725.
