and of the parish of Newport being sick and lying in bed but of sound memory
do hereby testify that I do hereby make for the same I give my soul to God -
my maker and my body to the earth from whence it came and after a Christian and
burial I give my estate which the Lord hath seen pleased to bestow on me as
follows 1791 After my just debts paid which is set down in a bill of passes at
my hand to it in the presence of the witnesses that witnesses this will being my
last will and testament.

I give to my brother John Cook one shilling and no more.

I give to my sister Bridget Rogers one shilling and no more.

I give to my sister Mary Stringer one shilling and no more.

The Remainder of my estate I give wholly unto Roger Howell and I do appoint
Roger Howell my whole and sole executor to see this my last will performed as
witnessed my hand this 25th day of March in the year of our Lord 1797. -
