made by me with such who of I have put my hand and seal this 5 day of
December 1726.

recovers of Francis ward the sum of Twelve pounds current money which
said money being due to Joseph Jones agreed by bill past and Contract for one
hundred acres of land by estimation more or less sold to the said ward by
the said Joseph Jones do the said recover by me this 1st day of May 1727.
Elizabeth Jones, William Finchin. Executors to the will of Joseph Jones deceased.

At a Court holden for the County of Wright County
the 24th day of September 1727.

The last will and Testament of Joseph Jones deceased also the above receipt of
the Executors of the said deceased was presented in Court by William Finchin
one of the Executors here in name who made oath thereto and
being proved by the oaths of the witnesses to the said will is admitted
to record as also the said receipt.

we the undersigned Edw James Ingle before
the last will and Testament of John Ingle
being in perfect sense and memory thanks be to almighty God for it this Eleventh
first day of December 1726.

I give and bequeath my soul to almighty God in hopes of a glorious Resurrec-
tion to eternal life and my body to be decently born to the grave and buried
and for all my worldly good that God of his mercy hath bestowed upon me
I have disposed of as follows [viz]

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Bynam an negro girl called
Lucy and an amulato boy called Ned the girl she hath already in possession I
give my Daughter Elizabeth my negro man after my wives decease to her
and the heirs of her body lawfully begotten for ever.

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Abigail Jones an amulato girl called Alice
and an amulato boy called Frank and the increase of the said girl to her and the
heirs of her body lawfully begotten for ever I give my Daughter Abigail
a feather bed and bolster I give to my Daughter Abigail all the land
that I have on that side of the branch that Edward Jones now lives.
