I. I Give to my Daughter Mary Barlow fifty Shillings in money &  
of four head of Cattle and four head of Horses One peacocke two  
pouter Poch and to plotes one feather Bed with its appurtenances  
belonging to it One Small Box and Two Ewes I give unto my Son  
Thomas Barlow all my Land to him and his Heires lawfully begotten  
forever I Give to Grand Daughter Sarah Carrile One Shillings Silver  
piece & Give the rest of my Estate to my Son Thomas Barlow  
after my Debts being first paid And I Do appoint him my sole  
sole Executor of this my last will and Testame<sup>t</sup> making void all others  
in Writing by me made herein is as witness to my hand this Nineteenth  
day of March 1729
