and memory thankd to god for it I do appoint this to be my last will & testament
making void and disannulling all other will by me made before and bequeath my soul
to god that gave it me and my body to the earth to be buried in a Christian like manner
now at the discretion of my executors my debts being first paid I give & left of my estate
in form & followed.

I give and bequeath unto my daughter one negro man named Jacob
to her and her heirs lawfully begotten forever bond bracteal & bond from self.
I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Anna Mather one negro girl named Eliza
and her increase to her and her heirs lawfully begotten forever all out her first
child and that I give to my daughter Susannah Mather after marriage to her and her
heirs lawfully begotten forever I give my best feather bed and furniture belong-
ing to it and four poster dishes and silver plated one pippard pan when she shall
come to the age of eighteen or marryed.

I give and bequeath to the child that now goeth without one negro girl named
Rachel and fifteen head of cattle this of them Cows and two Calves and
twelve Hogs & it is my desire that the cattle and Hogs should be for the young
child when it comes to the age of eighteen or marryed.

I give to my daughter Susannah Mather one feather bed with it furniture belong-
ing to it and one gold ring and twenty shillings to give her every year schooling where
she shall come to the age of eighteen or marryed. ~

I give all the rest of my estate to be equally divided between my four eldest
children and if either of the three youngest die without issue then legacy
to be equally divided among the four eldest and so as point George Ingles
and William Lyon my wife and so to executors of this my last will & testament
whereas it is advised by my Bar and Clerk the 28th day of June 1726 it is my desire
that George Ingles should take care of my children and their legacies
and that the work of the negro should be to maintain them. Esqur
