- I Give to my son John Crafts one small Iron Table.
- I Give to my son Samuel Crafts one feather bed and furniture one Couch
and Couch bed one Iron pott one best and what power he now has an
and more and all her increase one room & all the furniture.
- I Give to my Daughter Mary Crafts one trunk or bed and all that belongs to it.
- I Give to my Daughter Martha Brantly Twelve pence.
- I Give to my Daughter Mary Crafts one feather bed and furniture &c.
one best after her mother's decease.
- I Give to my Daughter Elizabeth Twelve Twelve pence.
- I Give to my son Thomas Crafts and my son Samuel Crafts all my land
I now live on to them and their heirs for ever.

child and that I Give to my Daughter Susanah Shaker after married to her and her
heirs lawfully begotten for ever I Give my best feather bed and furniture & belong-
ing to it and four powder dishes and six plates one Silver Spoon when she shall
come to the age of eighteen or married.

I Give and bequeath to the Child that I now possess with all one negro Girl named
Rachel and fifteen loads of Battens & two of them bowed and two coffers and
two Hoggs it is my desire that the Battens and Hogs should be for the nursing
Child when it comes to the age of eighteen or married.

I Give to my Daughter Susanah Shaker one feather bed with it furniture & belong-
ing to it and one gold ring and twenty shilling to give her every year when
she shall come to the age of eighteen or married. ~

I Give all the rest of my Estate to be equally divided between my four eldest ~
Children and if either of the three youngest die without heirs then legacy
to be equally divided among the four eldest and I do appoint Roger Sugram
and William Dixon my whole and sole Exors of this my last will & testament
wherein is as witness my hand this 17th day of June 1722. It is my desire ~
that Roger Sugram should take care of my Children and their legacies
and that the work of the negroes should be to maintain them. ~
