Item Give and Bequeath unto my Brother Jonathan Toyner my plantation  
 and Land where I live being Two hundred and fifty acres To him my  
 Said Brother Jonathan Toyner and his Heires forever  
 I give unto my Brother Mathew Toyner & my three Sisters Cherry  
 Catherine and Elizabeth Toyner to each one Guinea

Item I Give unto my Brother Alexander Toyner Two hundred and seventy  
 Five acres of Land out of the Survey of Land that I bought of Coll  
 Allen Beginning at the Lower end at a Corner tree a White Oak -  
 Landing in the Side of Cocke Swamp a Little below the mouth of  
 Round Hill and up round hill Swamp to the Dog Branch and up  
 the Dog Branch to the outside line To him my said Brother  
 Alexander Toyner and his Heires forever

Item I Give unto my Brother in Law John Dunkley the remainder or part  
 of the said Tract of Land that is from the mouth of the Dog branch  
 to the Upper end being One hundred and Twenty five acres to him  
 my said Brother in Law John Dunkley and his Heires forever -  
 I give unto my Brother in Law John Dunkley one Double loon &  
 Two pistoles and Twenty eight head of Hogs and One <sup>doz</sup> ~~doz~~ <sup>bush</sup> of pigs  
 And all the rest of my Estate Goods & Chattels whatsoever I give -  
 unto my Brothers Alexander Toyner and his Heires forever And -  
 Lastly I Do appoint my Bro. Alexander Toyner & my Brother in law  
 John Dunkley my whelers and Sole Exec. to this my last will and  
 Testament & making Disannulling and making void all other  
 Wills heretofore made by me My Willess whereof I have here  
 unto put my hand and Seal to this my last will and Testament  
 this 8 Day of April 1728 Tho. Toyner (Seal)

The last will and Testament of Thomas Toyner Junr Deed was
