cowster & 1/2 and to one of them named Mary Street I Give
one three year old Horse.

Item. I Give to my God Daughter Mary Prior one yearling Horse.

Item. all the rest of my whole Estate I Give to be equally divided
between my two sisters Elizabeth Smith & Mary Story.
I also make my two sisters my whole & sole Executors to see this
