Imp: - I Give and bequeath to Mary my dearly beloved wife ten head of cattle of two and three year of age and fourteen sheep young & old one dog of powder dishes, six powder plates, three Iron pots, one Copper pot and all my Hogg & young and old two Guns two horses, two Heathers cows and furniture two flocks cows and furniture two ~ Elephants one hog two small tables two saddles two dozen of powder spoons and all the rest of my goods and chattels I further Give to my said wife Mary all my lands and tenements by her freely to be enjoyed and enjoyed during her natural life and after her
